DARRELL ISSA VICTORY FUND - Legal Disclaimers:

The Darrell Issa Victory Fund is a joint fundraising committee (“JFC”) composed of: Issa for Congress (“Campaign”), Invest in a Strong and Secure America – ISSA PAC (“PAC”), and the National Republican Congressional Committee (“NRCC”) (collectively “the Committees”).

Any contributions to the JFC permissible under the Federal Election Campaign Act, as amended (“FECA”), 2 U.S.C. §§ 431 et seq., from donors who have not exceeded their applicable Federal contribution limits shall be allocated among the Committees pursuant to FECA and the following method:

1. The first \$2,500 from an individual donor shall be allocated to ISSA FOR CONGRESS for the primary election in 2012,
2. The next \$2,500 from an individual donor shall be allocated to ISSA FOR CONGRESS for the general election in 2012,
3. The next \$5,000 from an individual donor shall be allocated to ISSA PAC.
4. The next \$30,800 from an individual donor shall be allocated to the NRCC.
5. The first \$5,000 from a multi-candidate political committee shall be allocated to ISSA FOR CONGRESS, for the primary election in 2012;
6. The next \$5,000 from a multi-candidate political committee shall be allocated to ISSA FOR CONGRESS, for the general election in 2012;
7. The next \$5,000 from a multi-candidate political committee shall be allocated to ISSA PAC
8. The next \$15,000 from a multi-candidate political committee shall be allocated to the NRCC
9. Contributions from non-qualified federal political committees shall be allocated in the same manner as for individual donors set forth in this paragraph.

The contributor’s signature below shall serve as written designation of his or her contribution to the particular elections described above. All contributions permissible under FECA which would cause a contributor to exceed applicable Federal contribution limit to a specific committee, shall be reallocated to the remaining Committees to the extent permitted

by FECA according to this allocation formula. Any contribution that would cause a contributor to exceed any applicable Federal contribution limit, even after re-allocation, or is otherwise impermissible under FECA shall be refunded to the contributor. Any contributor may designate his or her contribution to a specific participating Committee(s), to the extent permissible by FECA. Any contributor may make his or her contribution payable directly to any of the specific participating Committee(s) listed in the Preamble to this Notice. Any such designated contribution that causes the contributor to exceed the contribution limit to the designated Committee shall not be reallocated by the JFC absent the prior written permission of the contributor as required by law.

Contributions to the JFC, or any of the participating committees individually, are not deductible as charitable contributions for Federal income tax purposes. All funds received in response to this solicitation will be subject to federal contribution limits and prohibitions. Contributions from corporations, labor union, foreign nationals without “green cards,” and federal government contractors are prohibited.

The maximum amount an individual or a non-multicandidate federal political committee may contribute to JFC is \$40,800. Individuals should review their personal contribution histories to determine how this contribution may affect their biennial aggregate contribution limit for the 2009-2010 election cycle. The maximum amount a multi-candidate political committee may contribute to JFC is \$30,000.

Federal law requires us to use our best efforts to collect and report the name, mailing address, occupation, and name of employer of each individual whose aggregate contributions exceed \$200 in an election cycle or calendar year, as applicable.
